8. Project Updates

KW gave an update on some of the ongoing projects:

Running Track – funding so far has come from Sugar Tax - £4000, Crowlees Ball - £3500, Walking and Cycling Public Health Project - £5000, a further £7000 is needed to complete the project.

Purchased from the £19,300 PFA donation made in Nov 2019 so far:

- £3,788.55 has been spent on the KS1 reading scheme
- £2,682 towards the cabin (£4,300 already received from the Aviva Grant)
- £90.00 Xmas books for KS1 children
- £1,980 year 5 & 6 Christmas Pantomime
- £165 Magic Tom (Year 4 Christmas Entertainer)

KW also shared with the group her 'Wish List' for the school.

Larger Projects include: Year 1 and 2 toilets refurbishment, Year 1 play cover area, Year 3 Cloakrooms, 100 ipads, outdoor benches and seating, Flooring, Assessment, KS1 Reading Scheme  
Smaller Projects include: MUGA basketball hoops, Music Stand storage, Lost Property Storage, Yoga Mats x 32, Athletics kit
