



### MATHEMATICS

- **Addition and Subtraction-** We will be learning about: adding together, addition facts, number bonds, taking away, counting backwards and fact families within 10. This will be a continuation from autumn 1.
- **Geometry-** we will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes and be able to recognise them.
- **Place Value-** We will be learning about teen numbers focussing on: counting forwards and backwards, tens and ones, one more and one less comparing and ordering.

### ENGLISH

- **Phonics-** we will be constantly revisiting phase 2 and 3 along with their tricky words. We will also be focussing on the phase 4 blends and tricky words.
- **Handwriting-** we will be continuing our focus on letter formation and how to structure a sentence, including: capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.
- **Repeated patterns-** we will be looking at stories with repeated patterns and creating our own versions.
- **Poetry-** we will be looking at poems and their features.

### OTHER INFORMATION

- Pennine Sports Coaches will be coming in to work with the children weekly. They will be focussing upon fundamental movement skills, turn taking, and communication along with lots of other skills.

### TOPIC

- **Computing** – Technology in our lives. the children will be learning how to use a computer, including: logging on, using a mouse pad and keyboard, opening a programme.
- **History** – Toys; the children will be learning about how toys have changed, within living memory, including the ways in which they were made and the materials they were made from. They will then be comparing them to toys today.
- **Geography** – We will be exploring the local area of Mirfield including: ariel view plans and human and physical features.
- **PE** – Gymnastics; the children will be learning how to balance and travel in different ways.
- **RE-** What do Christians believe God is like? And Incarnation.
- **PSHE-** Valuing Difference.
- **Art-** Painting. We will be focussing on Ashley Jackson and David Hockney including: colour mixing, observing and sketching landscapes and objects in the natural and man-made world.
- **Outdoor classroom-** The children will be accessing the outdoor classroom with Mrs Hardy, including campfire cooking.

### WAYS YOU CAN HELP AT HOME

- Listen to your child read every day for 5-10 minutes and discuss the text with them.
- Practise spellings and use Spelling Shed.
- Use Numbots to practise basic number skills.
- Support children with letter formation, including entry and exit strokes.
- Count forwards and backwards to 20.
- Regularly look at your child's Seesaw and complete any tasks set with your child.
