**CURRICULUM OVERVIEW YEAR 1: SUMMER 2**

**MATHEMATICS**

- **Geometry-** position and direction.
- **Number-** place value within 100.
- **Measurement-** money and time.

**ENGLISH**

- **Phonics-** the children will be completing their phonics screening check this half term, in class we will be continuing to revisit all of the sounds learnt so far.
- **Handwriting-** we will be continuing our focus on letter formation and how to structure a sentence, including: capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. As well as extending our work with adjectives and conjunctions.
- **Poetry-** we will be looking at different types of poems and their patterns.
- **Information texts-** we will be using information texts when learning about different animals.

**TOPIC**

- **Outdoor classroom-** The children will be accessing the outdoor classroom with Mrs Hardy. Including: pond dipping, the life cycle of a tree and a summer campfire.
- **Science-** animals and their habitats, linked with our **geography** where we will be learning about hot and cold areas in relation to the equator.
- **PE-** athletics, running and jumping.
- **Design and Technology-** moving animals and people.
- **Computing-** coding, we will be using BlueBots and scratch.
- **PSHE-** Growing and Changing unit of work.

**WAYS YOU CAN HELP AT HOME**

- Listen to your child read every day for 5-10 minutes and discuss the text with them. Practise recognising the phase 2, 3, 4 and 5 phonics sounds and segmenting and blending words with these in.
- Practise spellings and use Spelling Shed.
- Use Numbots to practise basic number skills.
- Support children with letter formation, including entry and exit strokes.
- Count forwards and backwards to 20.
- Regularly look at your child's Seesaw and complete any tasks set with your child.
