

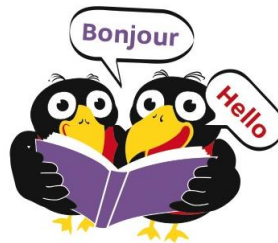


MATHEMATICS

- **Place value** Find 10 more/less, 100 more and less.
Recognise the place value of each digit in a 3 digit number – hundreds, tens and ones.
Compare and order numbers up to 1000
Count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100.
- **Addition & Subtraction** - Add and subtract numbers mentally, including a 3 digit number and ones, a 3 digit number and tens and a 3 digit number and hundreds.
- Add and subtract numbers with up to 3 digits, using formal methods of column addition and subtraction.
- Estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operations to check answers.

ENGLISH

- **Letter writing:** The children will read a text by Eoin Colfer as a class. They will write about the characters and will write formal and informal letters.
- **Spelling and Grammar-** Learning about what verbs, prepositions and adverbs are.
- Weekly spellings to practise at home.



TOPIC The Stone Age

- **Science** – Sorting, classifying and describing different rocks and learning where they come from.
- **Art** – Practising techniques in preparation for making a class cave display linked to the History Stone Age topic.
- **Computing** – Internet Safety – SMART crew. We are Communicators – emailing skills.
- **History** – Learning about life in the Stone Age. Using sources to ask questions and draw conclusions about this time in history. Stone Age day!
- **Music** – Learning about rhythm, introduction to musical notation. The Greatest Showman.
- **PE** – Learning some of the skills used in invasion games. Team building activities
- **PSHCE** – Emotional Coaching – Emotional Regulation and empathy.
