**CURRICULUM OVERVIEWS**

**MATHEMATICS**

- Adding and subtracting decimals within 1
- Adding and subtracting decimals with the same number of decimal places
- Problem solving with the above
- Adding and subtracting decimals with a different number of decimal places
- Multiplying and dividing decimals by 10, 100 and 1000
- Identifying angles
- Compare and order angles
- Measure and draw angles with a protractor
- Calculate angles on a straight line and around a point

**TOPIC- The Victorians**

**Science – Earth and Space** – The children will continue learning about the planets.

**Computing** – We are statisticians - The children will learn how to use Microsoft Excel to record and analyse data.

**Online safety** – Children will learn about how to use technology safely, respectfully and responsibly.

**History/Geography – Our local area.** The children will look at how Mirfield has changed since Victorian times by comparing maps. They will find out about the impact of canals and railways on Mirfield.

**PE – Tennis** – different tennis strokes, overhead serve, competitive games

**Music** – Journey to Space. Children will explore how to make cluster sounds, found sounds and use voice composition.

**RE – What did Jesus do to save human beings?**

**French** – levels of like / dislike, musical instruments, I play/I don't play...

**PSHCE** – Getting fit, different skills, independence and responsibility, star qualities

**ENGLISH**

**Narrative – Street Child by Berlie Doherty** - The children will read the story as a class and then, after some exploration of the text, they will write a predicted ending for the story. Story mapping, and writing in role. They will explore issues such as poverty and child labour linked closely with our history topic.

**Guided Reading** – Street Child by Berlie Doherty

**SPAG** – adverbs and modal verbs to indicate possibility, using the full range of speech punctuation, identify relative clauses, recognise relative pronouns and adverbs, learn spellings from the year 5 patterns, use subordinate clauses to add extra information, adding suffixes and prefixes to change words from nouns to verbs.

**WAYS YOU CAN HELP AT HOME**

- Practise spellings weekly in spelling booklet. Copy each word 5 times into the book. Then do further practise using the 'look, cover, write, check' method.
- Use the 'Spelling Shed' games to complete the weekly challenges. Click on 'More lists' and search for the other Year 5 word lists.
- Listen to your child read regularly and ask detailed questions about the books read at home.
- Encourage your child to practise their times tables and number facts on a weekly basis including TT Rockstars. Other websites for maths activities 'Mathsframe' - many games/activities are free and 'Hit the Button' website.
