- Click on **My Account** (at the top of the page)
- Click on **Register**
- Complete the form
- Click on **Register**

## How to renew your items

- Click on **Log In**
- Enter your library card number, without any spaces
- Enter your library PIN number - if you don't know your PIN, please contact your local library or email [frontline.services@kirklees.gov.uk](mailto:frontline.services@kirklees.gov.uk)
- Click on **log in**
- Click on **My Account** (at top of the page)
- Click on **Checkouts** and follow the instructions

## Forgotten your PIN?

- Click on **Log In** (at the top of the page)
- Click on **Forgot My PIN**
- Enter your Library Card Number
- Click on **Submit**
- Follow the instructions on the e-mail you will receive. Please check your junk mail folder.

Please note this is not an automated service and replies will be sent during officer hours.

You will still be able to place holds, on items in our catalogue, but the books will not be available for collection until further notice. Please check our E book collection as you may be able to find your chosen title available to download now.

## Privilege Expiring

If you log onto your account and have a message that your Privilege is expiring, please contact your local library, who will update your account. Every 3 years we check that the personal information on your account is up to date and that we are not holding any data we shouldn't be.
