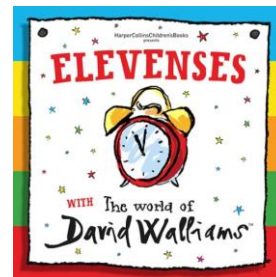


In addition to the above, it is important that your child:
