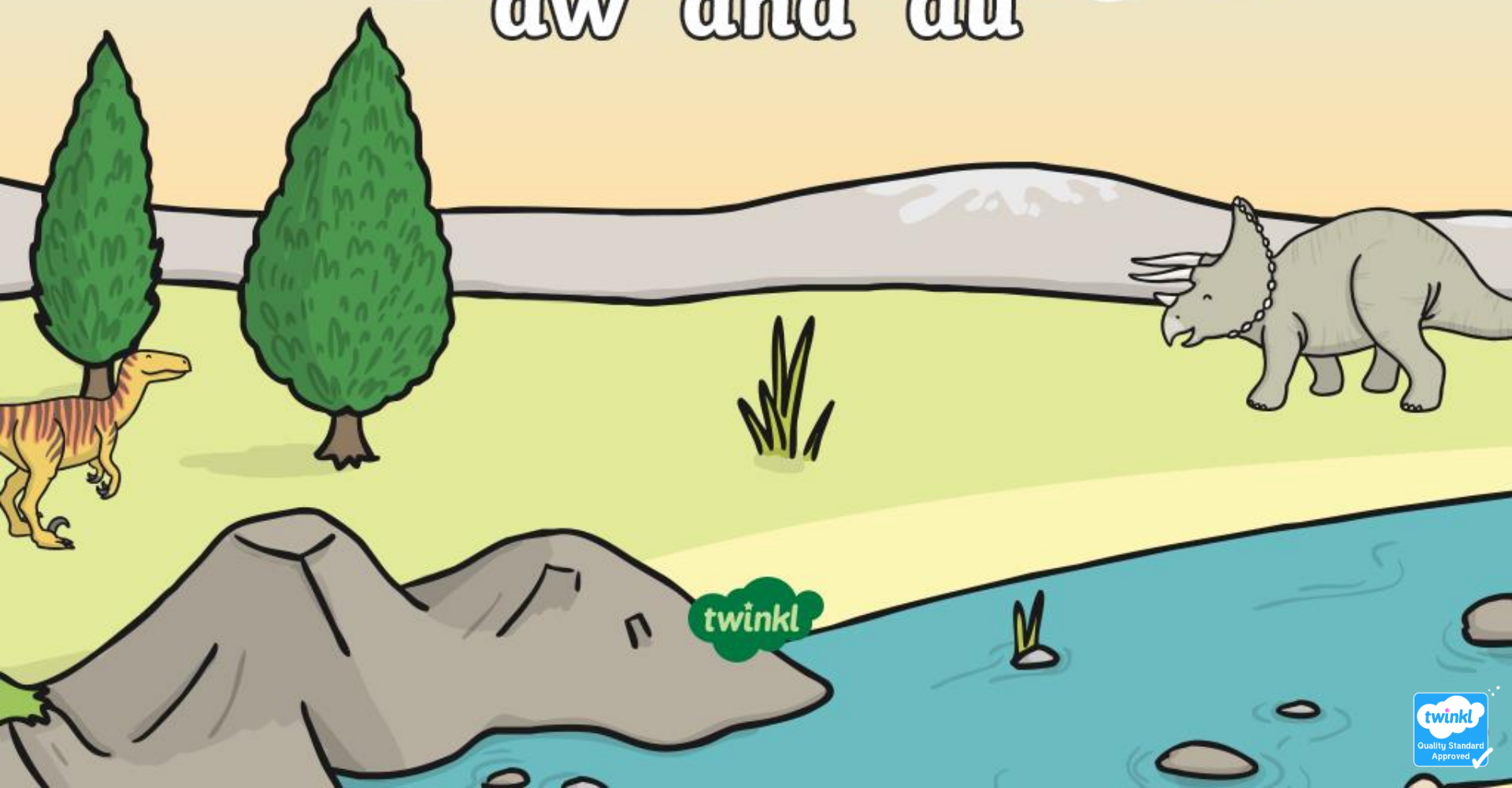
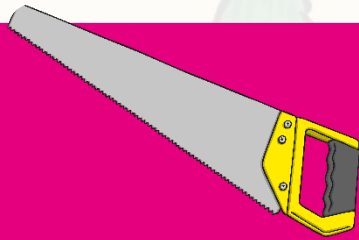

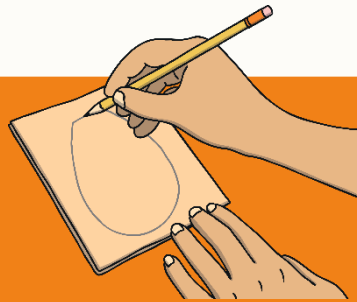


The Vowel Digraph 'aw'

crawl

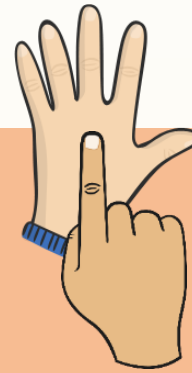

The vowel digraph 'au' makes the same /or/ sound in these words...



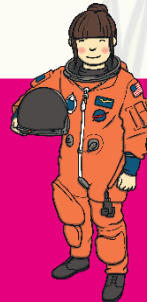

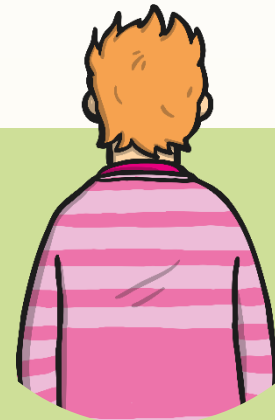
