



MATHEMATICS

Number and Place Value Children will:

- Count in steps of 2, 3 and 5 from 0, and in tens from any number, forward and backward.
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens and ones).
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers and compare numbers from 0- 100 using <, > and = signs.
- Read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and words.
- Use place value and number facts to solve problems.

Number- Addition & Subtraction Children will:

- Recall addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently and derive and use related facts to 100.
- Add and subtract numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representations and mentally.
- Show that addition can be done in any order and subtraction cannot.
- Recognise and use the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction.

TOPIC

Continents of the World & Materials

- **Science: Materials & Their Properties:** Children will identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials. They will work scientifically by observing, performing simple tests and identifying and classifying.
- **Design and Technology:** Children will test different materials to see which one would make the best kite, they will design their kite, construct a carp kite and a diamond kite. They will then evaluate their own creations.
- **ICT:** Children will learn how to send (including attachments) and reply to an email.
- **Geography:** Children will learn about the world's seven continents and five oceans and use maps, atlases and globes to locate them.
- **Music:** Feel the Pulse, children will sing songs and play instruments to help them 'feel the pulse'.
- **PE:** Gym and apparatus- learning how to do different jumps and rolls and putting them into a sequence.
- **RE:** Belonging, includes a visit to St Mary's Church.

ENGLISH

- **Stories:** Children will read and explore the themes in the book 'The Colour Monster'. They will compare the emotions of the characters to those of their own. Children will then focus on basic sentence structures when creating their own version.
- **Stories:** Children will be introduced to the four main characters from the Project X series. They will explore three of the stories in detail (The Silver Box, The Sandcastle and Hamster Rampage). Children will then write character profiles and alternative endings.



WAYS YOU CAN HELP AT HOME

- Read and discuss different text types to your child. E.g. non-fiction, narrative and poetry.
- Encourage and support your child to complete their set tasks on Timestables Rockstars and Spelling Shed
