Revision

- Fraction calculations- recapping over the four calculation strategies for fractions (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division)
- Reasoning with fractions- looking at how to solve a range of reasoning questions in preparations for SATs.

Investigations and Problem Solving

- We will carry out some different investigations such as 'Maths Murder Mysteries'.

TOPIC

- **History-** Slavery
