

### MATHEMATICS

- **Measurement**
  - Length and height
  - Weight and volume
- We will also be revisiting topics taught throughout the year so far in starters and independent tasks.

### ENGLISH

- **Phonics**- we will be constantly revisiting phase 2, 3 and 4 as well as continuing to learn phase 5 tricky words and sounds. We will be preparing for the phonics screening test in summer 2 by focussing on blending and segmenting real and 'alien' words.
- **Handwriting**- we will be continuing our focus on letter formation and how to structure a sentence, including: capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We will be extending our work using conjunctions and adjectives.
- **Information texts**- we will be using texts to enhance our foundation subject topics
- **Fantasy texts**- we will be reading the story Man on the Moon and learning about Buzz Aldrin, Neil Armstrong and Michael Collins.

### TOPIC

- **Outdoor classroom**- The children will be accessing the outdoor classroom with Mrs Hardy.
- **History**- we will be learning about some 'amazing people' from the past. This half term we will be focussing upon nurses Florence Nightingale, Mary Seacole and Nellie Spindler, we will then be looking at their similarities and differences.
- **Science**- Seasonal changes.
- **PE**- throwing and catching, including simple attacking and defending.
- **Art**- Weaving, this will be done both in class and using natural materials in the Outdoor Classroom.
- **Computing**- we will be continuing to learn how to use the programme WordPad, the children will be using this to create their own storybook.
- **PSHE**- Rights and Responsibilities unit of work.
- **RE**- Salvation, the story of Easter.

### WAYS YOU CAN HELP AT HOME

- Listen to your child read every day for 5-10 minutes and discuss the text with them.
- Practise spellings and use Spelling Shed.
- Use Numbots to practise basic number skills.
- Support children with letter formation, including entry and exit strokes.
- Count forwards and backwards to 20.
- Regularly look at your child's Seesaw and complete any tasks set with your child.
